From the Executive Director



DEAR FRIENDS:

It is my pleasure to present our fiscal year 2016 accomplishments to you. OAR's critical mission is accomplished through the collaboration of our volunteers, partners, donors, Board members, staff, and the community as a whole.

With your support, OAR worked with 2,421 participants this fiscal year. This includes 859 men and women who received reentry services both pre- and post-release, as well as 1,666 adults and youth completing community service hours through our alternative sentencing program.

This fiscal year was the pilot year of our new Intensive Reentry Program (IRP). This program focuses on individuals at medium to high risk of recidivism. I am excited to report that the program has a 90% success rate thus far, with only one of the individuals who has exited the program reentering

the criminal justice system. This intensive approach is drastically reducing recidivism for our participants and is changing lives! Looking ahead, please consider how you will continue your support of OAR. Please talk about our work with others, be an advocate for our mission, and consider how else you can be involved.

Let these pages inspire you and empower you. We can all feel proud of what we have accomplished this year together.

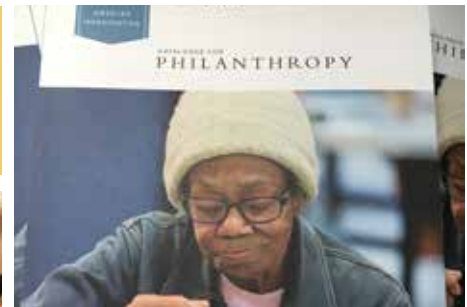

Restorative Justice: Community Service



Community Service Supervision –

for those under court order

Community service is a form of alternative sentencing. Through OAR's community service program, individuals are invited to take responsibility for past actions and repair the damage done by giving back to the community and providing a service that enriches the lives of others. OAR manages the community service function for Arlington County and City of Falls Church courts. Community service volunteers are placed at over 300 nonprofits, faith organizations, and government agencies within the DC metro.

Robert's Story

“Robert came to OAR after being ordered to complete 610 hours of community service in lieu of court costs. Robert was recently released from incarceration and shared that he was very depressed. He was concerned that he would never be able to get out of the debts he owed to the court. After our intake finished, he left feeling better. Robert opted to complete his community service at the American Legion in Arlington. He volunteered five days per week during the day, and went to work at night. Robert came into the OAR office to get his completion letter for his volunteer hours, and was full of gratitude. Robert completed all 610 hours in just eight months! He was in high spirits and very happy that his community service hours allowed him to pay off over \$12,000 in court costs. Robert shared that he hopes to continue volunteering at the American Legion in his free time!”

Reentry Services



Support for those incarcerated, nearing release and post-release

OAR provides pre-release programs individualized to local facilities including classes in essential life skill areas, as well as case management and employment services. Our Reentry Team provides transition assistance and employment coaching to individuals currently and previously incarcerated who are committed to avoiding re-incarceration and becoming established in the community.

Caleb's Story

“Caleb came home from prison in May, after serving a 23-year sentence. Thankfully, he had a stable and supportive friend to live with, but the matter of employment loomed large. Caleb had a strong work history prior to his incarceration and glowing references from his work in the prison, but the search was overwhelming. While he had built some computer skills up in prison, the world of online job applications was brand new, and navigating the

overwhelming data of job web-sites was a formidable task. Working with his OAR Case Manager in weekly sessions, Caleb was able to secure a part-time position at Goodwill. In addition, he needed another part-time job to make ends meet. Thankfully, a partner organization to OAR mentioned a need for a handyman, a job with flexible hours and good compensation. Caleb interviewed for the job and greatly impressed the employer, so much so that

they found even more work for him to do. He is saving money now, with an eye toward finding his own apartment. Additionally, OAR helped Caleb access funds from a local grant, which will allow Caleb to enroll in school to work towards earning his Commercial Driver's License. Caleb's profound determination, excellent people skills, and impressive work ethic are to credit for his quick success in the workforce; OAR is privileged to have helped open some doors along the way.”

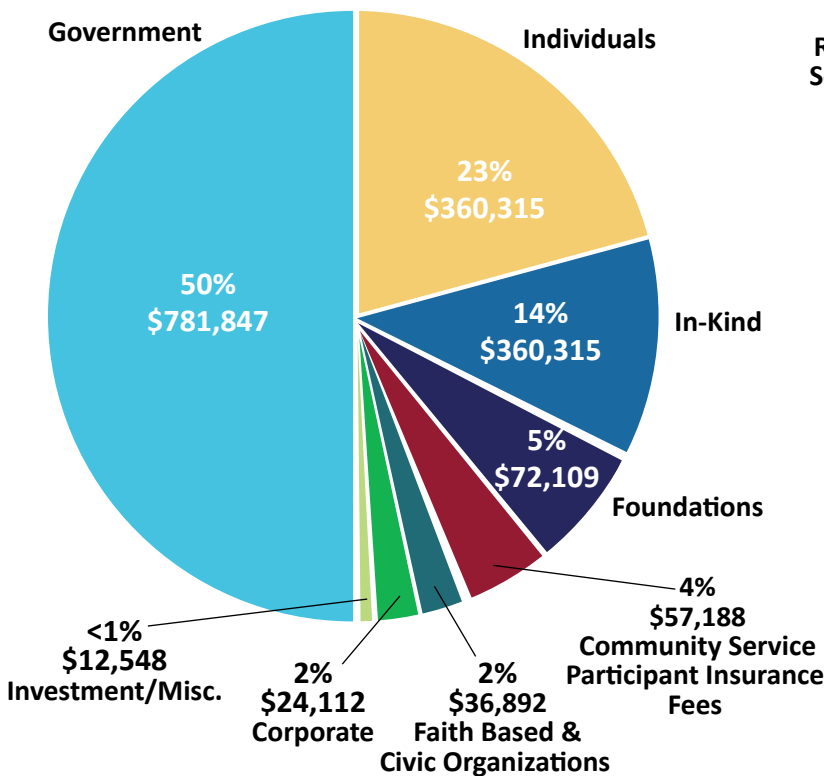

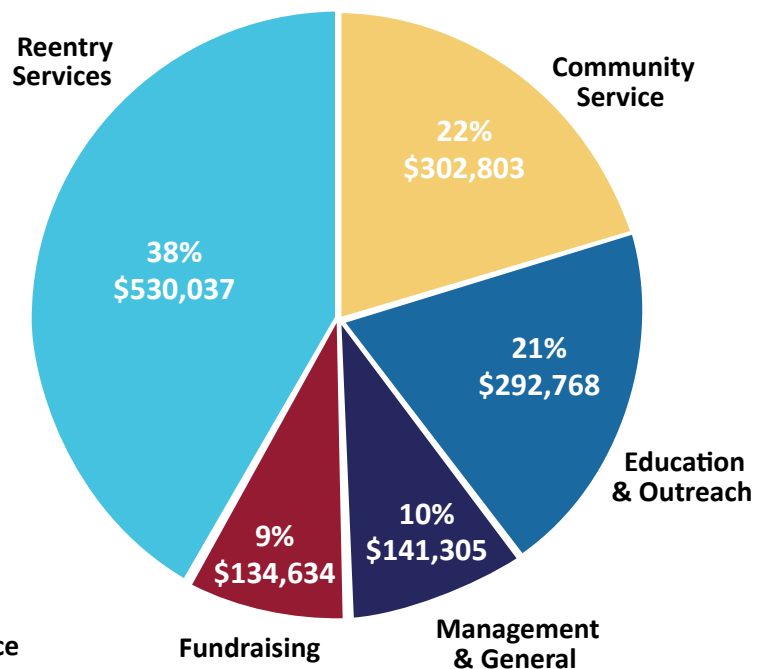
