OAR's 10th Annual Second Chance Fundraising Breakfast took place on Tuesday, April 24, 2018 at the Crystal Gateway Marriott in Crystal City with over 570 individuals in attendance to support second and fair chances. Senator Barbara Favola and Senator Adam Ebbin served as Honorary Co-Chairs for the event, and Harold Clarke, Director of the Virginia Department of Corrections, gave the keynote speech.

Guests heard the story of "Gwen"- a story about her journey in finding herself after returning home from incarceration with the help of OAR. In her story, Gwen stated, "If it were not for OAR, I would probably be either incarcerated again or would have gone back to an unhealthy relationship. OAR has helped me to live independently, and this has meant the world to me. OAR has been so supportive. I am really happy that I found OAR and really proud that I put in the work to get where I am today. I am finally beginning to feel promise and hope for the future, and that is truly a gift."

A Participant Story: Meet "Mila"*



Mila had 120 hours of court-ordered community service to complete. She worked with her OAR Community Service Case Manager to figure out a site where Mila could complete her hours. Mila chose to complete her hours at local faith community in Arlington, VA. Mila was able to finish all of her hours here, and she did such an outstanding job that her site

supervisor sent Mila's Case Manager a letter saying how pleased he was with Mila's work at the church. He wrote:

"It is my pleasure to commend Mila for her excellent performance during her community service at St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church in Arlington, VA, where she assisted with facilities maintenance. Over the past two months, Mila has worked under my supervision in the facilities department. She stands out above all the other volunteers I have supervised with her tireless work ethic, cheerfulness, and professionalism. Mila exhibited all the qualities of an ideal volunteer. She habitually arrived early to work. She was thorough in her duties, giving an impression of utmost professionalism.
