OAR is a Collective, non-dominant, decolonizing, pro-Black, racially just, radically joyful, deeply loving, come-as-you-are, liberated organization that puts participants first. We are on the journey with participants of all genders and their families impacted by mass incarceration and work to dismantle racism across all systems, especially the criminal legal system. Our "Upstream" work consists of our efforts in racial justice and liberation and we embrace racial justice and liberation in every aspect of our work, programs, and culture.

We lift the voices of Black, Indigenous, Latinx/e/o/a, Asian, and Multicultural (BILAM) people who have experienced racism and other intersecting forms of marginalization and challenge white people (WP) and those who have benefited from personal and systemic racism to become leaders in dismantling injustice and redressing the harm caused by personal racism.

Our Upstream Efforts include facilitating multiple intensive 10-week virtual learning cohorts for community members and especially those working in law enforcement and the criminal legal system that address liberation and dismantling whiteness.
