- If you are planning to go trick-or-treating or to any festivities adults/guardians please join kids under age 12 for trick-or-treating. If kids are old enough to be out without supervision, tell them to stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.
- Make sure you carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.
- For drivers slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited and may move in unpredictable ways.
- Popular trick-or-treating hours are 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Be especially alert for kids during those hours.
- Be safe, have fun, look out for others, and have respect for all.
