COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY AWARDED \$1 MILLION FOR DIVERSION PROGRAM



The U.S. Department of Justice has awarded a \$1,000,000 grant to the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney to expand the OAR Diversion Program.

Launched in 2022, the OAR Diversion Program was developed through a partnership with the Vera Institute for Justice, the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney for Arlington and the City of Falls Church, and OAR of Arlington, Alexandria and Falls Church. The OAR Diversion Program is part of Vera's Motion for Justice Program (MFJ).

Per the press release from the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney for Arlington and the City of Falls Church "MFJ brings together prosecutors' offices and system-impacted communities to design and pilot diversion programs that promote community safety by centering racial equity."
