Right now, we are centering hope.

Hope is what keeps us supporting one another every day, even when it feels impossible.

Hope is what brings us to this work each morning, advocating for social justice, for safe and stable housing, for access to essential resources, and for the right of every person to live with and care for their loved ones.

Participant Story



When Amani returned home, she carried more than just a small bag of belongings. She carried the weight of years spent away from her family, the uncertainty of where she would sleep, and the reality that finding a job or stable housing would not come easily.

Like many of the people we journey with, Amani had the determination to rebuild her life. But determination alone was not enough to overcome the barriers in front of her.

Through OAR, Amani received support for housing, helping her move into a safe, stable place of her own. With that stability, she began searching for work and, with support, secured a job that allowed her to provide for herself and reconnect with her family.

But what stands out most is not just what Amani accomplished. It is the way the community showed up around her.

From advocates who worked to ensure she could remain in the community, to supporters like you who make this work possible, Amani was not alone in her journey.

Today, Amani is rebuilding her life one step at a time. She is showing up for her family, planning for her future, and holding onto something that carried her through the hardest moments: hope.

This April, as we honor Fair Chances Month, stories like Amani's remind us that when people are given the support they deserve, they do more than survive. They rebuild, they reconnect, and they thrive.

And it all begins with a fair chance.
